An update from Daniel

It was a busy Autumn term leading up to Christmas and continues to be a busy and exciting time now that we are well into the Spring term. So busy that I completely overlooked producing a newsletter last term! - Sorry :(

Having received such a warm welcome by the 10 schools I visited during the Summer term, I extended an invitation (during one of my online assemblies) to visit any school that invited me. The messages started flooding in and during the Autumn term I was invited to lead collective worship in 19 schools across Somerset and Dorset, carrying out a total of 43 assemblies that term. I also produced 4 online assemblies as well as 9 addition videos including bible stories and quizzes. Other activities included Messy Church at Holy Trinity (Yeovil), helping musically with a Christmas Fair at Chilton Bridge School in Chilton Cantelo, leading a Christingle service at Cheap Street (Sherborne) & lots of carol singing!

All of the 19 schools visited in 2022 have booked me in again for the Spring term and I've also gained 2 more schools since then. Here are the themes for my collective worship assemblies:

'The Golden Rule' (Sept 22) - Using the verse from Luke 6:31 'Do to others as you have them do to you' as a memory verse and exploring what that means in real life. Hearing the story about the Good Samaritan and how the Samaritans and the Jews really didn't like one another, but the Samaritan was prepared to help the man in need, regardless of who he was or where he came from. A challenge for us all!

'Thank You' (Nov 22) - Thinking about all the people and things we are thankful for. Understanding the importance of saying thank you, and how those 2 simple words can have such a positive impact on the person receiving them. Hearing the story about the 10 lepers and how only one of them remembered to come back and say thank you to Jesus. Thanking Father God for creation and all the wonderful people he surrounds us with.

'Come + See' (Jan 23) - Thinking about what pops into our heads when we hear the words come and see? The special, important or exciting things that we might see or show someone after hearing or using those words. Hearing the story about Jesus' baptism and then learning how to navigate to the next part of the story in our bible by having a bible quiz. I then shared my 'Come + See' by given a personal message about my friend Jesus and what He means to me.

'Temptation' (Feb 23) - Thinking about the things that tempt us and hearing the bible story 'Tempted by the Devil' when Jesus walked through the wilderness and was tempted by the devil. Using this story to encourage us when we feel tempted to do or say something we know we shouldn't, particularly during Lent when we may have given up something or started doing something new. Also remembering that if we slip and give in to temptation, that Father God forgives us and we should try again and not give up!

I am hoping to create and upload some more online content leading up to the summer term. We are also currently planning our first **'Interactive Mini Mix'** that will take place on **Saturday 1st April 2023** from **10am** til 11:30am at **Cheap Street United Church** in Sherborne. We will be taking a journey from Palm Sunday to Easter Sunday. Please visit our website for more information.
